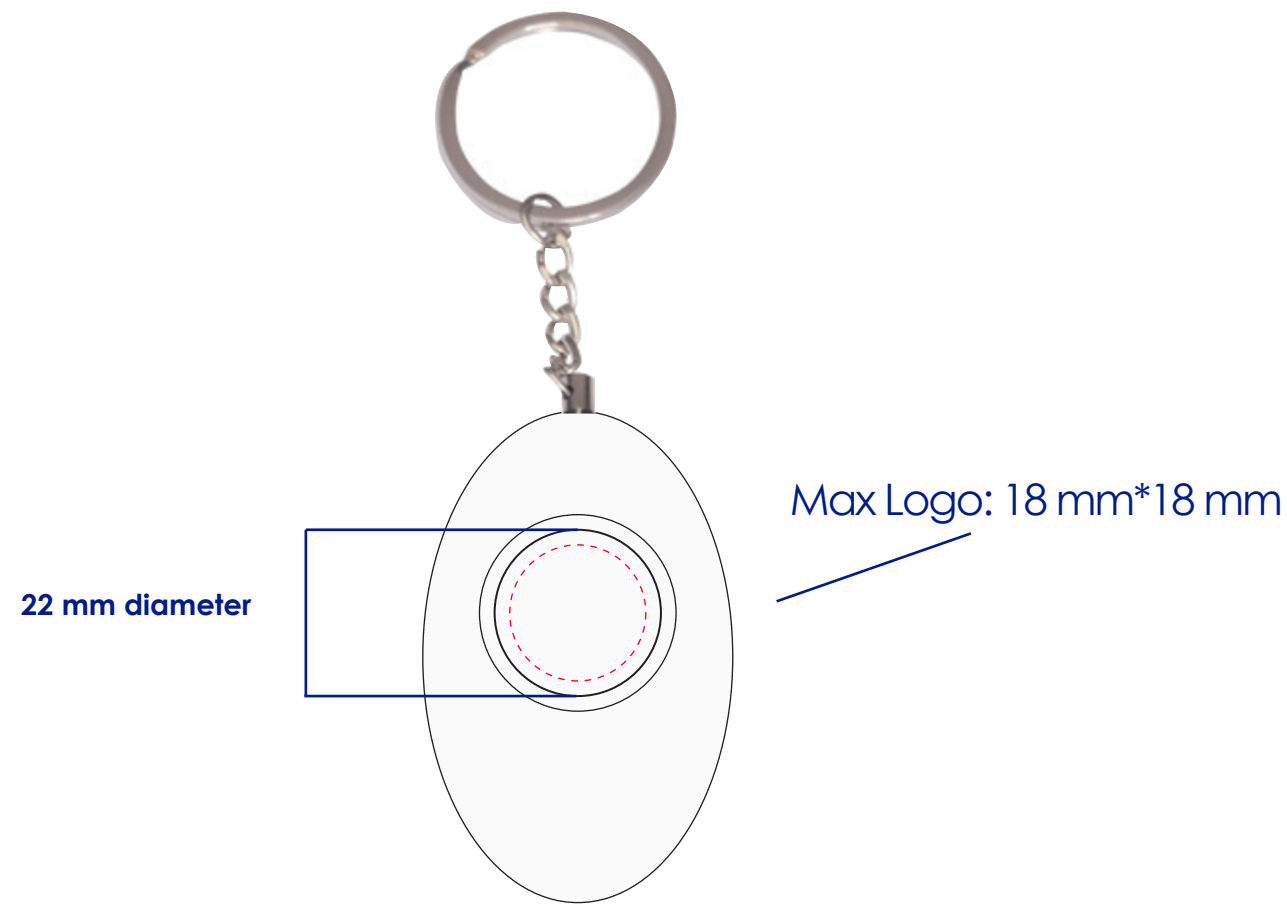

DIRECTIONS: Remove the plastic battery protection slip from back of alarm. To activate the alarm pull the pin from the plastic housing. A 120dB siren will sound. To de-activate, slide the pin back into the alarm until it snaps in place. It is recommended that the Personal Alarm be tested periodically to ensure battery performance. Replace the batteries if the Personal Alarm ceases to sound or the volume is low.

TO CHANGE BATTERIES: The shelf battery life is approximately 12 months (standby mode). It is recommended that the alarm power is regularly tested by discreetly activating the alarm. When the alarm siren goes weak, please replace the batteries with new ones. Using a screwdriver remove the battery cover on the back. Remove the old batteries and dispose of properly. Replace with three new LR44, 1.5V batteries as shown. Do not mix old and new batteries or mix batteries.

STORAGE: Remove batteries before storing the alarm for extended periods of time to prevent batteries from corroding and damaging the Personal Alarm.

REMEMBER: Do not solely rely on any self-defence product for protection. Avoid dangerous, isolated and poorly-lit areas, and travel with others where possible. Take reasonable precautions to avoid situations where self-defence will become necessary.

BATTERIES: Requires 3 x LR44, 1.5V alkaline batteries (included).

DISPOSAL: This item can be placed in domestic recycling where appropriate, taken to a recycling facility, placed in collection bins in large retail outlets or returned to Premier. Threshelfords. CO59SE. Please remove the battery and place in a separate waste stream.

CAUTION: Batteries may leak harmful liquids or ignitable materials or explode causing injury and product damage.

- Do not mix old and new or other battery types.
- Replace all batteries at the same time.
- Replace fully discharged batteries immediately.

PERSONAL ALARM

This Personal Alarm features a dual siren design with the two sirens sounding at different frequencies. The dual sirens oscillate to maximize attention. The compact design allows the Personal Alarm to be discreetly carried on a key ring, purse, etc. The idea is to be prepared, so take the Personal Alarm wherever you go. It is recommended the Personal Alarm be carried when walking alone, entering buildings, hallways, elevators, parking lots, etc.
